By the Chief, Allocations Branch:

1. Before the Commission for consideration is the Notice of Proposed Rule Making ("Notice"), 63 FR 36199 (1998), July 2, 1998, issued in response to a petition for rule making filed on behalf of Ronald L. Zahller and Kent Sager ("petitioner") proposing the allotment of FM Channel 233A to Yuma, Colorado, as that community's second local FM transmission service. Petitioner filed supporting comments in response to the Notice. No other comments were received.

2. In view of the interest expressed in providing an additional local aural transmission service to Yuma, Colorado, we will allot Channel 233A to that community, as requested.

3. As stated in the Notice, Channel 233A can be allotted to Yuma, Colorado, in conformity with the minimum distance separation requirements of Section 73.207(b)(1) of the Commission's Rules without a site restriction, applying the city reference coordinates at 40-07-30 NL and 102-43-24 WL.

4. Accordingly, pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 4(i), 5(c)(1), 303(g) and (r) and 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Sections 0.61, 0.204(b) and 0.283 of the Commission's Rules, IT IS ORDERED, That effective November 23, 1998, the FM Table of Allotments, Section 73.202(b) of the Commission's Rules, IS AMENDED with respect to Yuma, Colorado, as listed below:

5. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That this proceeding IS TERMINATED.

6. A filing window for Channel 233A at Yuma, Colorado, will not be opened at this time. Instead, the issue of opening a filing window for this channel will be addressed by the Commission in a subsequent Order.
