This is to advise the Commission that pursuant the Delaware Public Service Commission ("DPSC") has completed its review to determine the need for "public interest payphones" within Delaware and any appropriate program to provide for such needed payphones. See 47 C.F.R. § 64.1330 (c).

By PSC Order No. 4885 (August 25, 1998), the DPSC adopted the recommendation of its Hearing Examiner finding that there does now exist a need for public interest payphones and, consequently, that adoption of a Public Interest Payphone Program is not presently needed.
