Dear Ms. Salas:

On Thursday, November 6, Mr. Les Vadasz and Mr. Peter Pitsch of Intel met with Ms. Susan L. Fox, Senior Legal Advisor to Chairman Kennard. During that meeting the discussion included a review of Intel's position: on the reconsideration petitions of the FCC's Set-top box rules (Intel believes that the FCC's June decision was a good one and that compliance will be especially important in hybrid analog/digital markets); on the FCC's Section 706 proceeding (Intel's view are stated in the comments of the Internet Access Coalition of which Intel is a member); and that data networks should remain unregulated and free from universal subsidies.
