Dear Ms. Roman Salas:

On Wednesday, November 4, 1998, Lewis Chakrin, AT&T's Vice President of Corporate Development and I, and Howard Symons of Mintz, Levin, Cohn, Ferris, Glovksy & Popeo, P.C., on behalf of TCI, met with Paul Gallant of Commissioner Tristiani's office. During the meeting, Mr. Chakrin described the business reasons for AT&T's acquisition of TCI. These reasons included the need to provide a local telephony alternative to its residential customers, the desire to differentiate AT&T's service offerings, and the benefits associated with the broadband nature of TCI's facilities. Mr. Chakrin also reviewed the upgrades needed to enable TCI's cable plant to provide two-way, local services in a manner which will provide customers with the degree of reliability that they have come to expect from AT&T and the general rollout schedule for such upgrades.
