Dear Ms. Salas:

In accordance with Section 1.1206 of the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC" or "Commission"), the purpose of this letter is provide notification that the undersigned, counsel for Leaco Rural Telephone Cooperative, Inc. ("Leaco"), met this afternoon with Tom Power, Legal Assistant to Commissioner Gloria Tristani, to discuss the status of Leaco's above-referenced waiver petition. Counsel briefly discussed the burdens that Leaco would incur if it was required to set up a separate affiliate in order to provide interexchange service, and explained how grant of the waiver would serve the public interest. Counsel expressed Leaco's concern with the period of time that has passed without Commission action on its petition, and expressed its interest in expediting resolution of the waiver so that Leaco may proceed with its plans to offer interexchange service to its cooperative members.
