

The ARRL's proposal should be a minimum for restructuring.
Thus although the ARRL suggests four (4) classes, two (2) would be more efficient. A Technician licence for operation above 30 MHz and a General licence for all amateur privileges.

With respect to telegraphy, there is no real reason other than international treaty for keeping this requirement. Until the Treaty is changed the FCC should only require 5 wpm for the General Class licence (assuming that there are only two (2) classes. If the FCC adopts a regulation similar to the outline proposed by the ARRL then 5 wpm should be the top speed. As to the written exam the ARRL's proposal gives good guidance.
