

It has come to my attention that one of the directors of the ARRL has spread the false rumor that the FCC is proposing that the code speed requirement for the Amateur Radio License either be dropped to 5 wpm for all classes of licenses or to be done away with all together. In reading 98-143 I found no such provision .I believe you were asking for comments on the code speed requirements, not calling for any specific speed.

It is my opinion that the code speed requirements be left as they are presently written.

As to the other proposals in 98-143, I agree with your recommendations . I think that the enforcement of the rules should be done by volunteers, with the full backing of the FCC.
