The Chief, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, by his attorneys and pursuant to Section 1.246 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.246, hereby requests that, within ten days of the date of this request, the Metro NY LMR Association ("Metro NY") shall admit to the truth of the facts set forth below. Each response shall be identified by the same number as the subject admission request and shall be made under oath or affirmation by the person making the response.

Admissions

1. Metro NY does not hold any FCC authorizations permitting it to provide for-profit communications service.
2. Norcom Communications Corp. ("Norcom") provided some of the funds for the start-up of Metro NY.
3. Norcom provided all or substantially all of the funds for the start-up of Metro NY.
4. Norcom has paid some of the legal fees incurred by or on behalf of Metro NY for any purpose.
5. Norcom has paid all or substantially all legal fees incurred by or on behalf of Metro NY for any purpose.
6. Norcom has paid some of the legal fees incurred by or on behalf of Metro NY in connection with: (a) the formation of Metro NY; (b) applications for Station WPAZ643 ("Station"); (c) construction of the Station.
7. Norcom has paid all or substantially all legal fees incurred by or on behalf of Metro NY in connection with: (a) the formation of Metro NY; (b) applications for the Station; (c) construction of the Station.
8. Metro NY has no members.
9. Metro NY has never had any members.
10. Robert Nopper, individually, participated in the formation of Metro NY.
11. Robert Nopper, individually, prepared all documents relating to the formation of Metro NY.

12. Robert Nopper, individually, assisted in the preparation of Metro NY's FCC application(s) for the Station.
13. Robert Nopper, individually, prepared Metro NY's FCC application(s) for the Station.
14. Robert Nopper, as a principal of Norcom, participated in the formation of Metro NY.
15. Robert Nopper, as a principal of Norcom, prepared all documents relating to the formation of Metro NY.
16. Robert Nopper, as a principal of Norcom, assisted in the preparation of Metro NY's FCC application(s) for the Station.

24. Metro NY did not consider offers or bids for the management of the Station from any entity other than Norcom prior to entering into a management agreement with Norcom.
25. Metro NY and Norcom have the same mailing address.
26. Norcom has entered into resale agreements with intermediaries allowing these intermediaries to resell air time over the Station.
27. The intermediaries referred to in item (26) above may, pursuant to resale agreements with Norcom, resell air time over the Station on a for-profit basis.
28. The intermediaries referred to in item (26) above have, pursuant to resale agreements with Norcom, resold air time over the Station on a for-profit basis.

29. The Station was constructed and in operation within one year of the grant of the license to Metro NY.
30. The Station did not have 70 mobiles in operation for each of its authorized channels within three (3) years of grant of the license to Metro NY.
31. Norcom and Metro NY have utilized the same: (a) accountant(s); (b) attorney(s); (c) engineer(s).
32. Metro NY and Norcom have utilized the same office equipment.
33. Metro NY and Norcom have utilized the same office personnel.
34. Norcom has sold air time over the Station.
35. Norcom has sold air time over the Station only on a non-profit, cost shared basis.
36. Norcom has sold air time over the Stations on a for-profit basis.
37. Norcom has controlled the daily operations of Metro NY.
38. Norcom has had unfettered use of all facilities and equipment of Metro NY.
39. Norcom has determined and carried out policy decisions on behalf of Metro NY.
40. Norcom has been in charge of the employment, supervision and dismissal of personnel on behalf of Metro NY.
41. Norcom has been in charge of the payment of financial obligations, including expenses arising out of operation of the Station.
42. Norcom has paid all financial obligations, including expenses arising out of operation of the Station.
43. Norcom has received all monies and profits from the operation of facilities or equipment owned or leased by Metro NY.
44. Norcom has retained for its benefit all monies and profits from the operation of facilities or equipment owned or leased by Metro NY.


