Dear Mr. Tillotson:

This is in response to the petition for rule making that you filed on April 29, 1998, on behalf of Dudley Waller, proposing the allotment of Channel 247C2 at Troup, Texas.

We have reviewed your proposal and find that it is unacceptable for consideration at this time. A staff engineering analysis indicates that Channel 247C2 cannot be allotted to Troup in compliance with the Commission's spacing requirements. Channel 247C2, at the city reference coordinates (32-08-36 and 95-07-12) and at your specified site (32-17-56 and 94-58-54) is short spaced to vacant Channel 247C2 at Longview, Texas. Your proposal for Troup also conflicts with the two applications on file for Channel 247C2 at Longview (BPH-880812MZ and BPH-880816OC). You should be aware that the applications for Channel 247C2 at Longview were designated for hearing on July 24, 1990, in Docket No. 90-352, 5 FCC Rcd 5170 (1990). A Petition for Reconsideration filed April 3, 1998, is pending.

Based on the above, we are returning your proposal for Troup, Texas.
