The Morse code exam is no longer relevant.  
It's become a block that keeps otherwise well qualified  
people from becoming Radio Amateurs. It should be eliminated  
for Radio Amateur licensing immediately.  
If the commission sees a need to maintain a minimum of testing  
to comply with the ITU treaty section S25.5, the code testing  
should be no more than 5 WPM for any class license.  
a "sunset clause" should be added to Part 97 that would  
eliminate code testing as soon as the requirement in S25.5  
is struck from the ITU treaty.
