Dear Ms. Salas:

On Friday, January 22, 1999, Michael H. Hammer of Willkie Farr & Gallagher and Kathryn M. Fenton of Jones, Day, Reavis and Pogue, representing Tele-Communications, Inc. ("TCI"), and Mark D. Schneider of Sidley & Austin, representing AT&T Corp. ("AT&T"), met with Jonathan Radin, Walter D. Strack, and David Krech of the FCC's Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. During the meeting, the representatives of TCI and AT&T advised the FCC staff of the status of the drafting of a trust agreement with regard to the interest of Liberty Media Corporation in the mobile wireless telephone business of Sprint Corporation. The parties also reviewed with the FCC the progress of presenting to the Department of Justice that trust agreement, which is called for by the proposed Final Judgment filed with the FCC in this proceeding by letter dated January 4, 1999. The parties also discussed the prospective terms of the trust agreement and the compliance of those terms with the notes to Section 20.06, 47 C.F.R § 20.06, and FCC policy concerning interests held in trust.
