On Friday, January 29, 1999, the Cellular Telecommunications Industry Association ("CTIA"), represented by Brian Fontes, Senior Vice President, Policy and Administration and Michael Altschul, Vice President/General Counsel, met with Paul Misener, Senior Legal Advisor and Chief of Staff, Office of Commissioner Furchtgott-Roth regarding the above-referenced dockets. Specifically, the parties discussed the efficient use of numbering resources, including proposals to ensure carrier's efficiency through prescribed utilization thresholds. Additionally, the parties discussed the merits of CTIA's number portability forbearance petition. With regard to customer proprietary network information ("CPNI"), CTIA endorsed the industry position regarding audit trails and electronic flagging requirements. Lastly, the parties discussed CTIA's calling party pays ("CPP") petition pending before the Commission.
