ERRATUM

By the Deputy Chief, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau:

1. On December 30, 1998, the Commission adopted the *TTY Waiver Order*,¹ granting a temporary waiver of Section 20.18(c) of the Commission's Rules² to all parties who had filed petitions seeking waiver of that rule. The temporary waiver applied to all parties filing petitions as of the adoption date of the *TTY Waiver Order* (i.e., December 30, 1998), and all such parties were identified in the Appendix of the Order.³ Following release of the *TTY Waiver Order* on December 31, 1998, the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau became aware of the fact that two parties who did not file waiver petitions had been inadvertently included in the Appendix.⁴
