On Tuesday, February 2, 1999, James Cicconi, General Counsel and Executive Vice President, Lewis Chakrin, Vice President Consumer Services, Product Management, and I, of AT&T, and Michael Hammer of Willkie Farr & Gallagher, on behalf of TCI, met with Commissioner Gloria Tristani, Rick Chessen, Senior Legal Advisor, Paul Gallant, Legal Advisor, and Christi Shewman of the Commissioner's office. During the meeting, we discussed the deployment plan for upgrades to TCI's facilities to enable them to provide telephony and the most appropriate means by which to keep the Commission advised of our deployment efforts. In addition, we also discussed cross-subsidization concerns raised by some commentators. Our comments were consistent with our filings in the above-referenced proceeding.
