**WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS BUREAU'S
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

1. The Chief, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, by his attorneys, now requests that the Presiding Judge extend the date for filing proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law in this proceeding from March 26, 1999 to April 16, 1999. The Bureau also requests that the Presiding Judge extend the date for filing reply findings from April 16, 1999 to May 7, 1999.

2. The requested extension is necessary for two reasons. The primary reason is that the Bureau just received today the transcripts from the January hearing sessions. In setting dates, the parties and the Presiding Judge assumed that transcripts would be available approximately ten days after the end of the hearing. In fact, the Bureau did not receive the transcripts of the January sessions until a month after the hearing ended. Second, the Bureau's Enforcement and Consumer Information Division was moved to the Portals earlier than anticipated, and Washington counsel had to devote considerable time to moving and packing.

3. Counsel for Kay have been informed of the filing of this motion


