

I fully support the creation of 1000 and 100 watt LPFM radio.

Owners should be able to own more than the 5 station limit currently being considered. For LPFM to be a true training ground for radio and to improve community radio, LPFM's must have the option to be commercial. Without the financial incentive and ability to reinvest profits in the station and the community, serious broadcasters will be forced to forgo participation.
