


The telephone conversation concerned Spokane Television, Inc., licensee of KXLY-TV Spokane, Washington and the elimination of the Commission's one-to-a-market rule, 47 C.F.R. §73.3555(c). Mr. Kellman urged that the Commission should eliminate the one-to-a-market rule, or, in the alternative, permit Spokane Television, Inc. and its related companies to retain their current broadcast group which consists of one television station, KXLY-TV, Channel 4, Spokane, Washington, and seven radio stations, including KXLY(AM), KXLY(FM), KZZU(FM), KEZE(FM), Spokane, Washington; KKPL(AM) Opportunity, Washington; KHTQ(FM) Hayden, Idaho; and KVNI(AM) Coeur d'Alene, Idaho.

Dear Anita:

As a follow up to our conversation of Friday March 26, attached is an overview of the broadcast holdings of Morgan Murphy Stations and its affiliated companies, Spokane Television, Inc., Spokane Radio, Inc. and QueenB Radio, Inc. (collectively, the "KXLY Broadcast Group")

As you can see from the attached list, the KXLY Broadcast Group holds one television station, KXLY-TV, Channel 4, Spokane, Washington and seven radio stations, including KXLY(AM), KXLY(FM), KZZU(FM), KEZE(FM), Spokane, Washington; KKPL(AM) Opportunity, Washington; KHTQ(FM) Hayden, Idaho; and KVNI(AM) Coeur d'Alene, Idaho.

Conditional waivers of the one-to-a-market rule were granted for KKPL(AM), KHTQ(FM), KVNI(AM) and KEZE(FM).
