SUBJECT: Cellular Telecommunications Industry Association v. FCC & USA, D.C. Cir. No. 99-1045. Filing of a new Petition for Review in the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit.

This is to advise you that the Cellular Telecommunications Industry Association ("CTIA") on February 9, 1999, filed a 402(a) Petition for Review of: Policy and Rules Concerning the Interstate Interexchange Marketplace, Implementation of Section 254(g) of the Communications Act of 1934, as Amended, Petitions for Forbearance, CC Docket No. 96-61, FCC 98-347, released December 31, 1998.

CTIA challenges the Commission's rules and policies implementing the rate integration requirement codified at Section 254(g) of the Communications Act. It also seeks review of the Commission's denial of its petition asking the FCC to forbear from applying those policies to Commercial Mobile Radio Service (CMRS) providers.

The Court has docketed this case as No. 99-1045. The attorney assigned to handle the litigation of this case is Laurel R. Bergold.
