SUBJECT: Herbert L. Schoenbohm v. FCC, D.C. Cir. No. 98-1516. Filing of a Notice of Appeal in the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit.

This is to advise you that Herbert L. Schoenbohm on November 5, 1998, filed a 402(b) Notice of Appeal of: Application of Herbert L. Schoenbohm, WT Docket No. 95-11, FCC 98-267, released October 9, 1998.

Mr. Schoenbohm appeals the above-referenced Commission order that denied his petition for reconsideration of denial of his application for renewal of his amateur station and operator licenses on the grounds that he had not demonstrated that he possessed the basic character of truthfulness that is essential to licenseship. Mr. Schoenbohm asserts that the Commission's factual determinations were erroneous; the Commission failed to conduct a proper investigation; and, that the Commission's actions were arbitrary and capricious, and violated Mr. Schoenbohm's due process and equal protection rights.

The Court has docketed this case as No. 98-1516. The attorney assigned to handle the litigation of this case is Pamela L. Smith.
