Under consideration are 1) Joint Motion For A Further Extension of Time filed by The Association for East End Land Mobile Coverage, LMR 900 Association of Suffolk, and NY LMR ("Associations"), on April 21, 1999 and 2) Fifth Motion For Extension of Time filed by Norcom Communications Corp. on April 22, 1999.

Norcom reports that a tentative settlement of the issues has been reached. Associations report that more time than previously thought is needed for the directors to review the settlement proposals. Both petitioners requests that the time to respond to the Bureau's outstanding requests for discovery be extended.

Accordingly, FOR GOOD CAUSE SHOWN, the time for Norcom and Associations to respond to the Bureau's first set of interrogatories and its request for production of documents IS EXTENDED to May 14, 1999.
