Yesterday, Mark Rosenblum and I, both of AT&T, discussed with Kathryn C. Brown, FCC Chief of Staff, matters related to the captioned proceeding. We discussed the importance of extending the effective date of the liability rules adopted in the Second Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, released December 23, 1998.
