On Friday, May 7, 1999, I spoke with Kathryn C. Brown, FCC Chief of Staff, concerning matters related to the captioned proceeding. In particular, I explained AT&T's view that, because minority interests in cable operations generally do not afford control over video programming, such interests do not give rise to the public policy concerns relating to video distribution that led the Commission to adopt its now-suspended horizontal cross-ownership limitations. I otherwise made statements reflected in AT&T's written submissions in this proceeding.
