

Dear FCC,

PLEASE ALLOW THE NEW LPFM SERVICES! Local content and representation of our communities is generally absent from broadcast TV, with the majority, if not the entirety, of broadcasting controlled by large corporations. While cable companies sometimes provide local access television, not everyone in every community receives cable. The introduction of LPFM would be a tremendous compliment to fill this hole. It seems to be a win win situation since there will be negligible impact on current commercial stations.

Please allow commercially supported or non-commercial LPFM stations to have primary status. I would also suggest that 2nd and 3rd adjacent channel restrictions be dropped for LPFM stations. The FCC should use a "prohibited contour overlap" method of predicting interference and directional transmitting antennas should be utilized. It is very important that local ownership restrictions be in place as well.
