

The three attached files contain a joint press release of the Great Britain Government Radio Authority and the Radio Society of Great Britian. This is an announcement of Britain's new basic "A/B" Amateur license, which allows voice operation on the HF frequencies with 100 watts of power, and requires a 5 WPM Morse Code examination. I think it makes sense for the U.S. to at least follow suit by reducing the Morse Code requirement for the General class license to 5 WPM. However, I assert that it would be more appropriate to have no Morse code requirement for any Amateur license.
