Dear Ms. Salas:

On May 20, 1999, the Cellular Telecommunications Industry Association ("CTIA") represented by Brian Fontes, Senior Vice President for Regulatory Policy and Administration, Michael Altschul, General Counsel, Art Prest, Vice President for Science and Technology, and Tim Jeffries, Certification Programs Manager, met with Ron Netro, Dan Grosh and Martin Liebman, all with the Policy Division of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. Louis Linneweh and John Kalenowsky of Motorola participated via telephone.

The purpose of the meeting was to respond to questions posed by FCC staff concerning the timing of wireless 9-1-1 call processing.
