

Regarding Access Charge Reform, why aren't non-profit organizations, specifically hospitals and schools, exempted from these multi-business line charges? Certainly 501 (c) 3 organizations should not be responsible for paying both the cost of their POTS lines (here, \$10.32 a month) and an additional \$9.00 each month for Subscriber Line Charges (Network Access Charges) to cover the cost of the same line? Possibly non-profit organizations should only be paying the rate for primary residential service, or some other discounted rate which reflects both the urgency of the phone line and doesn't end up double billing them for the same service.
