Pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, I hereby submit an original plus one copy of this letter to notify you that David Otten of Celsat America, Inc. ("Celsat") and I met with Tom Tycz, Howard Griboff, Karl Kensinger and Chris Murphy from the staff of the Commission's International Bureau on Thursday, June 3, 1999. At the meeting, Celsat stated its preference for the flexible band plan approach (with modifications) to licensing 2 GHz applicants and expressed its reservations about the negotiated entry approach. Celsat also inquired about the staff's current thinking on the necessity of a second processing round for certain portions of the 2 GHz band.
