
This is inform the Commission that the undersigned was contacted today by Karen Gulick, legal advisor to Commissioner Tristani, pursuant to Section 1.1204(a)(10)(iii) of the Commission's rules, regarding the above-referenced proceeding which is currently on the "Sunshine Agenda" for the Commission meeting on June 10, 1999. Ms. Gulick sought information concerning the position of my client, the Association of Public-Safety Communications Officials-International (APCO), regarding a ten channel limit for trunked radio systems below 512 MHz. I indicated APCO's opposition to such a channel limit for the Public Safety Pool. Ms. Gulick further inquired as to APCO's position regarding granting of waivers for additional channel assignments. I responded that a better approach would be to include an express exception to the ten channel limit for those public safety applicants that demonstrate a need for additional channels based on loading and other similar requirements.
