
Dear Secretary Salas:

This letter is to record the June 10, 1999 meeting of R. Scott Zimmer, Executive Director, Educating Everyone Inc, with Rosalee Chiara of the FCC International Bureau. In the meeting, Mr. Zimmer discussed various aspects of the implementation of the FCC DBS Public Interest Obligations as reported in Docket MM 93-25.

Established in March 1998, Educating Everyone, Inc. is a Florida based not-for-profit private foundation whose mission is to provide quality distance education opportunities through multi-media services. Distance education, that is, the use of satellite, computer, television and Internet technology to overcome the barriers of time, space, and excessive costs that inhibit educational instruction, ensures that underprivileged groups have access to educational services. Educating Everyone (EE) distributes information, technology, services, and capital at various points in the distance education chain through a number of initiatives.

EE is actively working with a variety of potential educational programming entities to help fulfill the DBS public interest obligations. Ms. Chiara was provided an update of EE's activities in relation to the DBS public interest obligations.
