

**COMMENTS AND COUNTERPROPOSAL**

Legend Broadcasting, Inc. ("Legend"), licensee of Station KTMO(FM), Kennett, Missouri, by its counsel, hereby files its Comments and Counterproposal with respect to the Notice of Proposed Rule Making ("NPRM"), DA 99-867, released May 17, 1999, proposing the allocation of Channel 254A to North Tunica, Mississippi. Legend herein counterproposes that Channel 255C be reallocated from Kennett, Missouri to Munford, Tennessee, as that community's first local service, and that Station KTMO's license be modified accordingly. Additionally, we are herein proposing the allotment of Channel 254A to Friars Point, Mississippi as that community's first local service. In support thereof, the following is respectfully shown:

1. As indicated in its June 21, 1999 Comments and Counterproposal, in MM Docket No. 99-140, which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1, Legend proposes that Channel 255C be

reallotted from Kennett, Missouri to Munford, Tennessee at a reference point which is mutually exclusive with the proposed allotment of Channel 254A at North Tunica, Mississippi.<sup>1</sup> The reallocation of Channel 255C to Munford, Tennessee will constitute a first local service to that community. Munford is an incorporated community with 1990 census population of 2,326 (according to the 1996 census data the population of Munford is 3,941). Munford is governed by a mayor/alderman system of government. The city provides water, sewer, natural gas, police and fire services to its residents. The community has an elementary, a middle and a high school, numerous banks, commercial establishments, restaurants, churches, a public recreation center and its own post office.

2. Presently, Kennett, Missouri is adequately served. Besides KTMO(FM), commercial stations KBOA(AM), KTOC(FM) and KXOQ(FM) are licensed to Kennett, Missouri. Furthermore, non-commercial educational station KAUF(FM) is operating and licensed to Kennett. Consequently, the proposed reallocation of Channel 255C from Kennett, Missouri to Munford, Tennessee will not deprive Kennett of its only local service.

3. The proposed reallocation complies with the Commission's rules and would serve the Commission's allotment priorities and the public interest. In Amendment of the Commission's Rules Regarding Modification of FM and TV Authorizations to Specify a New Community of License, 4 FCC Rcd. 4870 (1989), recons. granted in part, 5 FCC Rcd. 7094 (1990) (hereinafter, "Community of License"), the Commission stated the proposed channel must be mutually exclusive with the existing channel and the new community must be preferred over the existing community under the Commission's allotment priorities. Since we are proposing the reallocation

of Channel 255C from Kennett, Arkansas to Munford, Tennessee, the Counterproposal is mutually exclusive with the current use of Channel 255C.

4. Further, the new community, Munford, will obtain a first local service, whereas Kennett will retain existing service from two commercial AM stations, one commercial FM station and a non-commercial FM station. Under the Commission's allotment criteria, a first local service is preferred over additional local services. See Revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures, 90 FCC 2nd 88 (1982).

5. As discussed in the attached Technical Statement, the instant Counterproposal proposes the relocation of the reference point of Channel 255C and reflects a site restriction of 41.7 kilometers north of Munford to avoid short spacing WYMX(FM), Channel 256C, Greenwood, Mississippi. While Munford is in Tipton County which adjoins Shelby County, Tipton County itself is not in the Memphis Metropolitan Statistical Area according to the 1990 Census. Further, the 70 dBu contour of the relocated KTMO will not encompass 50 percent or more of the Memphis urbanized area and, in fact, will provide less than 10 percent of 70 dBu coverage over the Memphis urbanized area.

6. Legend is herein also proposing the allotment of Channel 254A to Friars Point, Mississippi, which is also mutually exclusive with the instant proposal to allot that channel to North Tunica. Friars Point is a community with a 1990 census population of 1,334 individuals (Exhibit 2). Furthermore, there are presently no AM or FM radio stations, commercial or non-commercial licensed to Friars Point, Mississippi. Consequently, the proposed allotment of Channel 254A to Friars Point, Mississippi would constitute that community's first local service.

7. Also included in Exhibit 2 is a short historical sketch of the community of Friars Point, Mississippi. Friars Point was established in 1847 and was incorporated in 1850, first under

the name of “Union” which was changed to read “Point Friars.” Friars Point was reincorporated at the close of the Civil War in 1865. The community was the permanent county seat of Coahoma County until 1930 when it was moved to Clarksdale. Friars Point’s city government is composed of a mayor, five aldermen and a city clerk. The city provides police services, and there is a volunteer fire department. The city has several eating establishments, commercial establishments, the North Delta Museum, an elementary school, six churches, a bank and its own post office.

8. Legend’s instant Counterproposal must to be preferred over the North Tunica proposal. Legend is proposing a first local service to Munford, a well-established community with a 1990 population of 2,326 and the allotment of a first local service to Friars Point, Mississippi, a long established, incorporated community with a 1990 population of 1,334. In comparison, the NPRM proposes the allocation of Channel 254A as a first local service to only North Tunica, Mississippi, a CDP with a 1990 population of 1,314 persons.<sup>2</sup> Since Legend’s proposal provides the allotment of two first local services to two separate communities, each with a larger population than that single “community” proposed in the NPRM, it is clear that Legend’s proposal will provide a fairer, more efficient and more equitable distribution of radio facilities.

See Revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures, supra.

9. Furthermore, as reflected in the attached Technical Statement, the reallocation of Channel 255C from Kennett, Missouri to Munford, Tennessee will provide 60 dBu coverage to 1,343,557 persons in 26,483.5 square kilometers representing an increase in nearly 1,140,000 persons and 15,741 square kilometers over the currently authorized facilities. Since

KTMO(FM)'s present facilities only provide coverage to approximately 320,000 in 16,507 kilometers, the proposed reallocation of Channel 255C to Munford, Tennessee represents a 300 percent increase in population served by KTMO(FM), besides providing a first local service to a sizeable independent community deserving of service. Additionally, the allotment of Channel 255A to Friars Point, Mississippi will provide a new 60 dBu coverage to approximately 52,302 persons in 2,514.1 square kilometers and also provide a first local service to a new community. In comparison, the NPRM proposes to allot Channel 254A to North Tunica, Mississippi, which will only provide 60 dBu coverage to 32,927 persons in 2,515.3 square kilometers. Since all of the relevant areas presently receive five or more services, Legend's proposal should also be preferred on this basis that it provides service to substantially more people than that proposed in the NORM and is therefore far more efficient. See Greenup, Kentucky and Athens, Ohio, 68 RR2d 1437 (1991).

10. In conclusion, Legend's proposal must be preferred in the instant proceeding because Legend proposes the reallocation of Channel 255C from Kennett, Missouri to Munford, Tennessee, which will allow Station KTMO(FM) to provide a first local service to Munford, a community with a 1990 population of 2,326, and proposes the allotment of a first local service, Channel 254A, to Friars Point, Mississippi, a community with a population 1,334, whereas the NPRM only proposes a single first service to the CDP of North Tunica, Mississippi with a population of 1,314. Additionally, Legend's reallocation of Channel 255C to Munford will allow KTMO to provide 60 dBu to over a million more people than it presently does and the allotment of Channel 254A to Friars Point alone will provide service to 20,000 more people than the North Tunica proposal. Therefore, Legend's proposal is clearly superior to that proposed in the NPRM and must be preferred under the Commission's allotment priorities.

11. Section 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, requires that the Commission allot channels “among the several states and communities.” The Commission has defined “communities” as a geographically identifiable population groups. Generally, if the community is incorporated or listed in the U.S. Census, that is sufficient to satisfy its status for allotment purposes. However, that presumption is not irrebuttable, and the Commission has concluded on more than one occasion that even though an area is listed as a CDP, it is not necessarily a community for allotment purposes. See Douglas and Unionville, Georgia, 9 FCC Rcd 154 (1994); East Hemet, et al., California, 4 FCC Rcd 7895, 7896 (1994); Searles Valley, California, 3 FCC Rcd 5221 (1988). See also Wyeville, Wisconsin, 10 FCC Rcd 7234 (1995) (“We do recognize that Wyeville is incorporated and listed in the Census, meeting the basic criteria for community status. However, we may find that a population grouping . . . does not constitute a community for allotment purposes where the community may be devoid of the customary factors associated with determining community status, such as a library, schools, shopping centers, churches, a newspaper and social or civic organizations and some form of government.”). In this case, while the NPRM suggests that North Tunica is a “community” because it appears in the U.S. Census, in fact, North Tunica contains none of the indicia that the Commission commonly associates with community status. The presumption of community status is therefore rebutted in this case. North Tunica contains none of the social, economic, governmental or cultural components that the Commission generally associates with community status. North Tunica has no internal governing body, mayor, city hall, chamber of commerce, and no municipality providing services of any kind. It has no local commercial or social organizations. Attached hereto as Exhibit 3 are relevant pages from the Bell South Yellow Pages for North Delta, the area in which North Tunica is located. There is, however, no listing for North Tunica.

There is no postal zip code for any community named North Tunica. See Searles Valley, California, supra (Searles Valley does not qualify as a community for allotment purposes, in part, because U.S. Postal Service does not recognize it as a separate area). There are no schools listed as being in North Tunica. Neither are there any hospitals, clinics, nor physicians who identify themselves as being associated with North Tunica. There are no banks listed in North Tunica. Neither are there libraries, newspapers, social and/or civic organizations or shopping centers located in North Tunica. While there are several businesses and municipal services associated with the community of Tunica, there do not appear to be any associated with North Tunica. Rather, North Tunica appears to be a mere neighborhood which adjoins Tunica. Therefore, since North Tunica does not have the indicia of community status, it does not qualify as such for allotment purposes.

12. Petitioner hereby states that should the Commission grant the instant Counterproposal to reallocate Channel 255C from Kennett, Missouri to Munford, Tennessee and modify Radio Station KTMO(FM)'s license accordingly, petitioner will file an application for the new facilities and implement that application expeditiously after Commission grant. Additionally, petitioner states that should the Commission grant the instant proposal to allot Channel 254A to Friars Point, Mississippi, petitioner will file an application for those new facilities and will implement that application expeditiously after Commission grant.

Accordingly, for the reasons stated above, Legend Broadcasting, Inc. respectfully requests that the Commission deny the proposal in the NPRM to allot Channel 254A at North Tunica, Mississippi and instead grant Legend's mutually exclusive counterproposal to reallocate Channel 255C from Kennett, Missouri to Munford, Tennessee, at the reference point proposed herein, and

additionally allot Channel 254A at Friars Point, Mississippi, as each community's first local service and amend the Table of Allotments to reflect the foregoing.



**COMMENTS AND COUNTERPROPOSAL**

Legend Broadcasting, Inc. ("Legend"), licensee of Radio Station KTMO(FM), Kennett, Missouri, by its counsel and pursuant to the Notice of Proposed Rule Making ("NPRM"), DA 99-819, in the above-referenced Docket, released April 30, 1999, is hereby filing its Comments and Counterproposal with respect to Legend's Petition for Rule Making ("Petition") proposing the reallocation of Channel 255C from Kennett, Missouri to Keiser, Arkansas and the modification of KTMO(FM)'s license to specify operation at Keiser. In these Comments, and as will be explained, Legend respectfully requests that instead of reallocation Channel 255C to Keiser, the Commission reallocate Channel 255C to Munford, Tennessee. In support thereof, the following is respectfully shown:

1. As reflected in the Commission's April 30, 1999 NPRM, Legend had originally proposed in its Petition that Channel 255C be reallocated from Kennett, Missouri to Keiser, Arkansas and that Station KTMO(FM) have its license modified to specify operation at Keiser. In the interim, however, Legend has discovered a more beneficial allocation arrangement and

herein counterproposes that in lieu of the reallocation of Channel 255C from Kennett, Missouri to Keiser, Arkansas, the channel instead be reallocated to Munford, Tennessee as that community's first local service.

2. Munford has the social, economic and governmental indices to qualify as a community for allotment purposes (Exhibit 1). According to the 1990 Census, Munford has a population of 2,326.<sup>1</sup> Munford, located in southwest Tipton County, Tennessee, is governed by a mayor/alderman system of government. The city provides water, sewer, natural gas, police and fire services to its residents. Munford has an elementary, a middle and a high school. The community has numerous banks, commercial establishments, restaurants, churches, a public recreation center, and its own Post Office. However, no AM or FM stations are currently licensed to Munford, either commercial or non-commercial. Consequently, the allocation of Channel 255C to Munford, Tennessee will constitute its first local service.

3. As previously indicated in Legend's Petition, Kennett, Missouri is adequately served. Besides KTMO(FM), commercial stations KBOA(AM), KTOC(FM) and KXOQ(FM) are licensed to Kennett, Missouri. Furthermore, non-commercial educational station KAUF(FM) is operating and licensed to Kennett. Consequently, the proposed reallocation of Channel 255C from Kennett, Missouri to Munford, Tennessee will not deprive Kennett of its only local service.

4. The proposed reallocation complies with the Commission's rules and would serve the Commission's allotment priorities and the public interest. In Amendment of the Commission's Rules Regarding Modification of FM and TV Authorizations to Specify a New Community of License, 4 FCC Rcd. 4870 (1989), recons. granted in part, 5 FCC Rcd. 7094 (1990) (hereinafter, "Community of License"), the Commission stated the proposed channel

As discussed in the attached Technical Statement, the instant Counterproposal proposes the relocation of the reference point of Channel 255C and reflects a site restriction of 41.7 kilometers north of Munford to avoid short spacing WYMX(FM), Channel 256C, Greenwood, Mississippi.<sup>2</sup> While Munford is in Tipton County which adjoins Shelby County, Tipton County itself is not in the Memphis urbanized area according to the 1990 Census. Thus, Munford is not located in any urbanized area. Further, the 70 dBu contour of the relocated KTMO will not encompass 50 percent or more of the Memphis urbanized area and, in fact, will provide less than 10 percent of 70 dBu coverage over the Memphis urbanized area. See Technical Exhibit attached hereto.

7. The relocation of KTMO will provide significant public service benefits at the proposed site. First, as noted above, Munford must be preferred for a first local service over Kennett. Further, KTMO operating at Munford, Tennessee will provide 60 dBu coverage to


1,343,557 persons in 26,483.5 square kilometers representing an increase in nearly 1,140,000 persons and 15,741 square kilometers over the currently authorized facility.<sup>3</sup> KTMO's present facilities only provide coverage to approximately 320,000 persons in 16,507 square kilometers. Therefore, the proposed reallocation to Munford, Tennessee will represent a 300 percent increase in population served by KTMO(FM) and will also provide a first local service to a sizeable independent community deserving of service.

8. Petitioner hereby states that should the Commission grant the instant proposal to reallocate Channel 255C from Kennett, Missouri to Munford, Tennessee and modify Radio Station KTMO(FM)'s license accordingly, petitioner will file an application for the new facilities and will implement that application expeditiously after Commission grant.

Accordingly, for the reasons stated above, Legend Broadcasting, Inc. respectfully requests that the Commission amend its Table of Allotments to reallocate Channel 255C from Kennett, Missouri to Munford, Tennessee in order to provide a first local service and to modify the license of Legend.




