Re: Request for Waiver of Regulatory Fee

Dear Ms. McCrary:

This is in response to your request for waiver of the annual regulatory fee for the Canby T.V. Club. You assert that the Commission previously waived the fee for Canby's translator system, and that Canby's translators are supported by voluntary donations from members of the community.

In implementing the regulatory fee program, the Commission stated that it would waive its regulatory fees for community based translator stations that are supported by the members of the community served. Implementation of Section 9 of the Communications Act, FCC 95-257, ¶ 16, released June 22, 1995.

The Commission automatically waives the fees for community based translator systems. Thus, the annual regulatory fee for Canby's translator system is waived. The waiver shall remain in effect indefinitely, and Canby T.V. Club will not be required to pay regulatory fees, or to request waivers of those fees in the future, unless there is a substantial change in the ownership or financing of its translator operation.

Dear Ms. McCrary:

This is in response to your request for waiver and refund of the Fiscal Year (FY) 1995 regulatory fees for the television translator system operated by Canby TV Club. You maintain that the translator system is operated and maintained by residents of the community served, and that Canby TV Club is dependent on voluntary donations from members of the community for funds.

In implementing the regulatory fee program, the Commission stated that it would waive its regulatory fees for any translator station that:

(1) is not licensed to, in whole or in part, and does not have common ownership with, the licensee of a commercial broadcast station; (2) does not derive income from advertising; and (3) is dependent on subscriptions or contributions from members of the community served for support.

Implementation of Section 9 of the Communications Act, FCC 95-257, ¶ 16, released June 22, 1995.

It appears that Canby TV Club's translator system is not licensed to, and does not have common ownership with, any commercial broadcast stations, that Canby TV Club does not sell advertising, and that its income is derived from voluntary donations from the families served by its system. Under these circumstances, your request for a waiver of the regulatory fees for Canby TV Club is granted and the fee paid will be refunded.

Mr. Tom Putnam of the billings and collections offices at the FCC called and reminded me that our permission to be silent had expired on May 6 1997. Fortunately, our 1997 regulatory fees were paid prior to our request for waiver.

However, it is incumbent upon me to respectfully ask again for your permission to remain silent until the construction is complete. In addition, we request your permission that that our silenced be recognized as retroactive. I have enclosed a copy of the engineers' construction detail for your review. This detail is per the FCC guideline requirements submitted by your offices for both stations.

As you are aware, our progress has been slow. Nevertheless, it has been steady and in a forward direction. The Caribbean is a market in need however it is not as up to speed as the states. Permits and approvals and site confirmation takes longer. The cable company for St. Croix St. Thomas and St. John are under new ownership and we have been forced to renegotiate. This area is under the must carry but unfortunately not all cable companies like to recognize this law. We are hopeful that consideration will be eminent. Mr. Putnam directed me to the FCC publications offices so that I could obtain a much needed copy of the CFR 47. With all of the LPTV concerns on the table, I have been reassuring those involved with our construction that LPTV is still alive and well. If it is ok with you I would like to give our engineers your name and number just incase they have any questions.
