## Competitive Pricing Division of the Common Carrier Bureau Announces Filing of Payphone Service Proceeding Reconsideration Petition Supplement in CC Docket No. 96-128

On April 21, 1999, The Colorado Payphone Association filed a petition for partial reconsideration of the *Implementation of the Pay Telephone Reclassification and Compensation Provisions of the Telecommunications Act of 1996*, CC Docket No. 96-128, Third Report and Order, and Order on Reconsideration of the Second Report and Order, 14 FCC Red 2545 (1999). On June 9, 1999, the Commission released a public notice of the filing of this petition. On June 15, 1999, public notice of this petition filing appeared in the *Federal Register*, specifying that oppositions to this petition must be filed on or before June 30, 1999, and that replies must be filed within 10 days of June 30.

On May 19, 1999, The Colorado Payphone Association filed a motion for leave to supplement its petition for partial reconsideration in CC Docket No. 96-128, together with the supplement to its petition. The Competitive Pricing Division hereby denies the motion and treats the supplement as an *ex parte* submission in CC Docket No. 96-128. See 47 C.F.R. § 1.429(d).

This proceeding is a "permit-but-disclose" proceeding in accordance with the Commission's *ex parte* rules. See 47 C.F.R. §§ 1.1200, 1.1206. Persons making oral *ex parte* presentations are reminded that memoranda summarizing the presentations must contain summaries of the substance of the presentations and not merely a listing of the subjects discussed. More than a one or two sentence description of the views and arguments presented is generally required. See 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206(b). Other rules pertaining to oral and written *ex parte* presentations in permit-but-disclose proceedings are set forth in 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206(b).
