Dear Mr. Walker:

This is in response to your request for reduction of the Fiscal Year (FY) 1998 regulatory for Peoples Wireless, Inc., licensee of AM Radio Station KDKO, Littleton, Colorado. You argue that because you operate with reduced nighttime power, there is a substantial decrease in your nighttime protected contour.

The FY 1998 AM regulatory fees were calculated relying on both the daytime protected city grade contour, and class of station. The fee schedule thus accounted for the different operating parameters of different classes of stations. Accordingly, your request for a reduction in the FY 1998 regulatory fee is denied.

The Commission is cognizant of the problems faced by Class D stations and their obligation to provide protection to other licensees. You can obtain more information to determine if you can upgrade your nighttime signal by calling the Commission's National Call Center (toll free) at (888) 225-5322.

Dear Sir:

This request is for a reduction in Regulatory fees for the radio station KDKO AM-1510 of \$3,250.00.

I request the reduction because the amount is a considerable hardship on the licensee. Although the city's population is 1,578,616, the present wattage of KDKO does not cover most of the area after sundown and before sunrise. We are 24 hours, 10,000 day and 1,300 night. We loose most of our coverage when we reduce to our night directional. Therefore, we loose our listeners and we have no advertisers. (revenue)

Winter months are extremely difficult for us. We loose our directional very early, as early as 4:30 p.m. Therefore, revenue is way down and the station operates on a very low revenue.

Our format is Urban. 95% of our audience is in the Denver Metroplex, that is almost nonexistence at night directional and our day directional is the same, until sunrise, some months 7:15 a.m. Most of our audience is already at work.

I am sure you are aware of this pattern, but, I am also enclosing our day and night directional to better explain our situation.

I would be very pleased if you can direct us to a way of improving our pattern or maybe able to remain at our 10,000 watts until midnight, reduce to low power until 4 a.m. and resume to high power again for better coverage of the communities for which we serve.
