1. SAE Broadcasting Company ("SBC"), by counsel, in accordance with 47 CFR §§ 1.415 and 1.420, hereby submits its Comments in the above-captioned proceeding. In support thereof, SBC states as follows:

2. On May 21, 1999, the Commission released a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking ("NPRM") in the above-captioned proceeding in which it proposed the allotment of Channel 300A to Easton, California as its first local aural transmission service.

3. SBC supports the allotment of 300A to Easton, California, for the reasons stated in the NPRM. If the Commission assigns Channel 300A to Easton, California, SBC will apply for a construction permit and will construct a new facility upon award of that permit.


