The Commission has requested that MCI Telecommunications Corporation (MCI) withdraw its Application For Review, filed on April 28, 1993, in the above-referenced docket, noting the lapse of time and intervening decisions by the Commission on the subject matter. MCI WorldCom continues to believe the Commission should require fundamental cost-based unbundling as part of its Open Network Architecture (ONA) policy, so as to better serve enhanced service providers (ESPs).
