

I applaud the efforts of the FCC in the creation of this proposal. The airwaves are community property that has been practically given to large media organizations. This has hampered the efforts of small groups of people to be heard. I support this resolution.

As to the split between LP 1000, LP 100, and LP 1-10, I believe that all three low power categories should be only licensed to non-profit groups. As such, they should not be held to the stringent criteria of commercial stations. Meeting some of the higher levels of protection requires a large capital investment that most non-profits would not be able to afford.

Perhaps a middle ground would be to only license the LP classes to non-profits and require that LP 1000 follow more stringent criteria than the LP 100 and LP 1-10.
