Dear Valued GST Customer:

Earlier this month PCI Communications and GST Telecom Pacific, Inc. ("GST") sent you a letter notifying you of an agreement whereby, subject to regulatory approval, PCI would acquire certain telecommunications assets of GST, and PCI would become your telecommunications service provider.

PCI is pleased to announce that it has received from the FCC a waiver of its slamming verification rules to enable PCI to become your carrier, and that the transition of your account to the PCI network is complete. We would like to take this opportunity to welcome you, and to let you know that we look forward to serving you.

As a PCI customer, you will continue to receive the same service that you received with GST, at equal or lower rates, and no charges or fees will be imposed as a result of the transfer.
