**AMENDMENT TO PETITION FOR RULEMAKING**

Lake Area Educational Broadcasting Foundation, ("Lake Area"), licensee of Station KCVJ(FM), Osceola, Missouri, hereby request that the Petition for Rule Making filed on April 12, 1999, which in part proposed a change in the channel of operation of Station KCVJ from Channel 222A to Channel 285A, be amended, and that the Table of Allotments with respect to Osceola, Missouri instead be modified as follows:

<u>Community</u>	<u>Current</u>	<u>Proposed</u>
Osceola, Missouri	222A	262A

Petitioners also request the modification of the license for KCVJ.

As seen by the Engineering Statement attached hereto as Attachment 1, adoption of this proposal would be in full accord with the Commission's technical spacing rules.<sup>1</sup> Moreover, full predicted full city-grade service can be provided to the community of allotment from the reference coordinates. Lake Area withdraws its support for the previously-filed request to change channels of operation from Channel 222A to Channel 285A.




