On August 3, 1999, Stephen Garavito, Michael Lamb, David Lawson, and the undersigned, all representing AT&T, met with Deborah Lathen, Chief, Darryl Cooper, Sunil Daluvoy, Imani Ellis-Cheek, Thomas Horan, Michael Lange, Anne Levine, Jason Oxman, and Andrew Wise, of the FCC's Cable Services Bureau. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the non-exclusive agreement AT&T has with Microsoft for the purchase of Microsoft's TV software platform in advanced set-top devices and both party's agreement to showcase new digital cable services in 3 U.S. cities. AT&T also discussed its intent to use set-top software from multiple suppliers in its cable operations.
