On August 9, 1999, Stephen Garavito, David Lawson, Terry Wingfield, and the undersigned, all representing AT&T, met with Imani Ellis-Cheek, William Johnson, Anne Levine, To-Quyen Truong, and Andrew Wise of the FCC's Cable Services Bureau, and Thomas Krattenmaker and Howard Shelanski of the Office of Plans and Policy. The purpose of the meeting was to present information regarding joint venture arrangements AT&T is attempting to negotiate with members of the cable industry for the purpose of providing local residential telephony services over HFC plant. More specifically, we discussed the status of AT&T's on-going discussions with Time Warner and Comcast, among others. No documents were provided during the meeting.
