Dear Ms. Salas:

My name is Phillip S. Caplan, Sales Manager, of Teltronic of Baltimore Inc. a telecommunications reseller. I would like to reply to the FCC and state that I agree with the comments filed by Houston 2-Way Radio, a telecommunications dealer, in the proceeding that a portion of the spectrum at 746-764 and 776-794 should be made available to private wireless radio services.

Teltronic of Baltimore currently sells telecommunications equipment to private wireless customers that range from small business owners with only a couple of two-way radios up to large commercial users with in excess of 100 units. We are finding it difficult to find adequate frequencies for our customers in our area and that this shortage is causing our customers undue hardships.

We at Teltronic of Baltimore believe this band would be a suitable location for private wireless use as it is close to the existing private land mobile radio spectrum, making it easier for manufacturers to deploy products there quickly.

I would like to thank the FCC for considering the needs of private wireless licensees in this proceeding and encourage you to allocate additional new spectrums as soon as possible.
