ERRATUM TO  
**"MOTION TO WITHDRAW AND DISMISS COUNTERPROPOSAL"**  
TO WITHDRAW AND MODIFY TO  
**"MOTION TO WITHDRAW AND DISMISS PART OF COUNTERPROPOSAL"**

On July 21, 1999, the Commission issued a Public Notice in the above-captioned proceeding (Report 2346) reflecting the filing of several Counterproposals, including one by Sonoma Media Corporation, ("Sonoma") in this Docket. The Public Notice was subsequently reissued and corrected by a further Public Notice issued by the Commission on July 29, 1999. On August 3, 1999, Sonoma, by counsel, filed a pleading entitled "Motion to Withdraw and Dismiss Counterproposal", which is still pending. The pleading was in error to the extent that it indicated a total withdraw and dismissal of the Counterproposal, and to that extent, the Motion is withdrawn.

It is Sonoma's desire and request to withdraw and dismiss only part of its counterproposal, specifically, that portion that requested a change of allocations in Cross Plains, Texas. Specifically, Sonoma wishes to dismiss and withdraw only the following part of its Counterproposal:

In all other respects Sonoma wishes to indicate its continued commitment to prosecute all other parts of the Counterproposal as submitted, and submits herewith 1/ the Declaration of Roy E. Henderson, 100% shareholder of Sonoma and 51% owner and Chief Operating officer of Rawhide Radio LLC, successor to Sonoma as licensee of KVCQ(FM), reiterating the commitment of Rawhide to all statements made in the Sonoma Counterproposal, except for the specific portion relating to Cross Plains which is withdrawn above, and including the commitment to reimbursement of all affected channel changes and the commitment to construct and operate the upgraded channel allocation of KVCQ from Cuero to Luling as requested in its Counterproposal if allocated by the Commission.

Wherefore, Sonoma Media Corporation respectfully requests that its prior "Motion to Withdraw and Dismiss Counterproposal" be withdrawn and corrected to the instant "Motion to Withdraw and Dismiss Part of Counterproposal", and that the Sonoma Counterproposal, as now modified and prosecuted by Rawhide Radio LLC, Successor in interest to Sonoma be considered and granted in the public interest.



DECLARATION

ROY E. HENDERSON, under penalty of perjury hereby states and declares the following:

That I am the President and sole shareholder of Sonoma Media Corporation, which has been the the sole licensee of Radio Station KVCQ(FM) in Cuero, Texas; and

That Sonoma is the sole proponent of a rulemaking counterproposal filed on December 21, 1998, in MM Docket No. 98-198, styled as Table of Allotments for Cross Plains, Texas, in which it was requested, inter alia, that KVCQ's operating channel of 249C3 in Cuero be moved and upgraded to channel 249C2 in Luling, Texas, and KVCQ's license be modified to that upgraded channel and new community of license.

That on August 3, 1999, I executed a Declaration requesting withdraw and dismissal of the Sonoma Counterproposal in docket 98-198, that that request was in error, and that Sonoma only wishes to request the withdraw and dismissal of a part of that counterproposal, that is the following:

and in all other respects intends to continue prosecution of its Counterproposal as submitted, with Rawhide Radio LLC as the new licensee of KVCQ(FM). As majority shareholder and Chief Operating officer of Rawhide, successor to Sonoma as Licensee of KVCQ(FM), Roy E. Henderson reiterates the commitment of Rawhide to all statements made in the Sonoma Counterproposal, except for the specific portion being withdrawn above, including the commitment to reimbursement of all affected channel changes and the commitment to construct and operate the upgraded channel allocation of KVCQ from Cuero to Luling as requested in its Counterproposal if allocated by the Commission.


