**REQUEST FOR REVIEW**

Western Heights Public School District ("District") pursuant to Sections 54.719-54.721 of the Rules hereby seeks review of the Decision of the Universal Service Administrator in connection with the FRNs referenced above.

**I. Question presented for Review:** Whether for E-rate purposes the Commission should accept the "Feeder Pattern Method" as an alternative means to calculate the total number of students in a school district eligible for free or reduced price lunch under the National School Lunch Program.

As this request for review raises a novel question of policy, it should be considered by the full Commission. 47 CFR 54.722(a).

**II. Request to Consolidate with Pending Request for Review**

Pending before the Commission is a request for review that the District filed on June 22, 1999 (FRN 156635). As the Commission's decision in this matter could affect the amount of funding due the District in the pending matter, we ask the Commission to consolidate the two and decide them together.

**III. Administrative History/Statement of Facts**

The Schools and Libraries Division of USAC ("SLD") issued Funding Commitment Decision Letters to the District in connection with application numbers 42040, 54054, and 67359, respectively, on January 31, February 9, and February 18, 1999. (Exhibit 1) In each Commitment Letter, the SLD assigned an 80% discount rate to the District's only middle school, a 60% discount rate to the District's only high school, and a 78% shared discount rate to the District as a whole.

On February 24, 1999, the District appealed the discount rate decisions the SLD made in all of the above referenced applications, referring to number 67359 as the application in Wave 9 not yet received. (Exhibit 2). Along with its appeal, the District submitted documentation showing that the SLD should have assigned a 90% discount rate to both its middle and high schools, and thus an 88% shared discount rate to the District. The lower discount rate, the District's evidence plainly showed, did not accurately reflect the high percentage of middle and high school students in the area who come from impoverished homes.

The District advised the SLD that it had calculated the 88% shared discount rate using a combination of well-accepted methods. It had relied on traditional head-counting for elementary school students because the free and reduced lunch eligibility data collected for them is generally reliable and on the "Feeder Pattern Method" for middle and high school students for whom the opposite is true due to wide-spread and well documented under-reporting.

Several months passed with no notice from the SLD concerning the status of the District's appeal. But as the weeks went by, information gleaned from occasional public statements made by SLD officials led the District to believe that this appeal would take longer than most to decide because it involved a policy issue that the SLD could not decide on its own. We were resigned, therefore, to wait patiently.

By early July, however, we in the District and the consulting firm that manages our E-rate application process were becoming increasingly concerned about the lack of any official word from the SLD. Therefore, on July 20, 1999, our consultant called the SLD Customer Service Bureau to inquire about the status of our appeal. He was shocked to discover, as I was when I learned about it later, that the SLD had rejected the appeal in a decision dated May 11, 1999, a decision which the District never received.

The next day, Peter Malone from SLD Customer Service faxed a copy of the SLD's decision to John Harrington, one of our consultants, who in turn immediately faxed it to me. (See affidavit of Joseph Kitchens).

In its decision dated May 11, 1999 (received by the District on July 21, 1999), the SLD refused to increase the District's middle school rate from 80% to 90%, the high school rate from 60% to 90%, and, therefore, the shared discount rate from 78% to 88%. (Exhibit 3). In support of this determination, the SLD reasoned as follows:

According to program rules the Feeder Method of determining free and reduced lunch eligibility is not a legitimate method of determining discount percentages. The Feeder Method is based on the assumption that one school in the district should have eligibility rates similar to the higher percentage schools in the district that feed into them. Under program rules, each school building's free and reduced lunch eligibility must be based on the actual students currently enrolled in that building.

The U.S. Department of Education, with all due respect to the Commission's highly able and professional staff, has far more experience than the Commission studying elementary and secondary school populations. We urge the Commission, therefore, to defer or at least to accord significant weight to that agency's longstanding practice of accepting the Feeder Pattern Method as a reliable mechanism to compensate for the under-reporting of NSLP eligibility that typically occurs among middle and high school students. It is important to keep in mind that equitably distributing funds on behalf of financially disenfranchised students is one of the Department of Education's primary missions. Under Title I of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (20 U.S.C. 6301-6514), for example, the Department awards billions of dollars in grant money to state educational agencies, who in turn distribute funds to schools that have high percentages of low income students.

Just like the E-rate regulations, the Department of Education's Title I regulations require state agencies to distribute funds first to the most economically disadvantaged schools. Also like the E-rate regulations, Title I demands that state agencies use specific data, such as the number of students eligible for free or reduced price lunch, to ensure that those agencies accurately measure the poverty levels in schools before distributing any funds. (See [http://www.ed.gov/legislation/ESEA/Title\\_I/attend.html](http://www.ed.gov/legislation/ESEA/Title_I/attend.html) )

In contrast to the SLD's unduly narrow interpretation of the E-rate regulations, however, the Title I regulations expressly permit, if not encourage, using the Feeder Pattern Method to count more accurately the number of middle and high school students eligible for free or reduced price lunch. In this regard, we direct the Commission's attention to the following Q&A from the Department of Education's web site: ([http://www.ed.gov/legislation/ESEA/Title\\_I/attend.html](http://www.ed.gov/legislation/ESEA/Title_I/attend.html) )

Q10. Is there any flexibility in how an LEA may count children from low-income families in middle and high schools?

A. Of the four measures of poverty the statute permits an LEA to use for identifying eligible school attendance areas and allocating funds to those areas, eligibility for free or reduced-price lunch is by far the measure most frequently used. Yet, we know from experience that high school and middle school students are less likely to participate in free and reduced-price lunch programs than are elementary school students. Hence, those schools often may not be identified as eligible for Title I services or, if eligible, may not receive as high an allocation as their actual poverty rate would require. In order to address the situation, an LEA may use comparable data collected through alternative means such as a survey. Also, an LEA may use the feeder pattern concept. This concept would allow the LEA to project the number of low-income children in a middle school or high school based on the average poverty rate of the elementary school attendance areas that feed into that school.

## **IV. Discussion**

### **A. Timeliness of the Appeal.**

In these circumstances, it would be both unfair and inequitable not to treat this request for review as having been timely filed. To decide otherwise would penalize the District for an event completely outside of its control. In this regard, we urge the Commission to take into account all of the following considerations:

- (a) the District received no notice of the SLD's decision until July 21, 1999;
- (b) the District neither knew nor had any reason to know that a decision had been issued before that date;
- (c) the District was accustomed to long delays associated with the program and reasonably believed that the long delay in this instance was due simply to the subject matter of the appeal; and
- (d) the District is aware of numerous cases where official SLD documents have been misdirected or for a wide variety of other reasons outside of the control of the intended recipients failed to reach their intended destinations.

### **B. The Feeder Pattern Method**

The FCC has established as a first priority disbursing E-rate funds to school and library applicants in communities where poverty is at its most extreme. We are, therefore, disappointed, confused and, quite frankly, perplexed by the SLD's refusal to accept the Feeder Pattern Method as an acceptable alternative means of calculating the number of high school and middle school students eligible for free or reduced price lunch. This method ultimately paints a sadder, yet far more realistic, picture of the socio-economic condition that exists among this large segment of our school population. While we would love to report lower incidences of poverty in our District, reality simply does not permit us to do so. Sometimes we hear that numbers don't lie, but in this case, unfortunately, they do.

The Feeder Pattern Method is based on the logical assumption that middle schools and high schools should have NSLP eligibility rates similar to the elementary schools that feed into them. The middle school and high school NSLP eligibility rates can then be calculated based on a student-weighted average of the eligibility rates at a district's elementary schools. In our district, for example, the percentage of students eligible for free or reduced lunch at each elementary school based on applications on file is 85.5%, 72.2%, 90.1%, and 78%. The percentage of eligible students at our high school based on applications on file is 44.1%. (See Exhibit 2). As you can see, there is no logical correlation between the application-based percentages at the elementary schools and high school in our district.

Western Heights School District submitted a free and reduced lunch count to the SLD that was certified, legitimized, endorsed, and supported by the Oklahoma State Department of Education, School Lunch Division. (See Exhibit 2; letter from Dee Baker, Executive Director, Nutrition Programs). This is the same agency that the SLD relies upon routinely to verify the NSLP data submitted by E-rate applicants from the State of Oklahoma. Significantly, this agency did not say that the District's count of eligible middle and high school students eligible for free or reduced price lunch was speculative, which, we believe, may be one of the Commission's concerns. To the contrary, the Oklahoma State Department of Education was unequivocal. It declared that it was "convinced" that the District's reported NSLP eligibility data using the Feeder Pattern Method "accurately depict[ed] the potential number of eligible free and reduced students in attendance at both Western Heights Middle School and Western Heights High School."

Thus, in the final analysis and consistent with the statement of program rules articulated in the SLD decision, it certainly may be said that District's NSLP data for the District's middle and high schools was based on the "actual students currently enrolled" at both locations. To arrive at those school numbers, the District used a method that both the Oklahoma and United States Departments of Education routinely accept and endorse. Moreover, the State Department of Education reviewed and approved the *specific* NSLP data that the District submitted to support its discount rate calculations. Ironically, had SLD's Program Integrity Assurance staff checked directly with the state agency, which they regularly do when discount issues arise, that agency would have confirmed the District's discount-related data without hesitation.

On behalf of the students of Western Heights Schools, who deserve their full and fair share of funding for technology under this extraordinary program, I urge the FCC to accept the Feeder Pattern Method as an alternative discount calculation mechanism and to reverse the SLD's decision.

## **V. Relief Sought**

The District respectfully requests that the Commission issue an Order reversing the decision of the SLD and directing the SLD to increase the discount rates of all of the FRNs listed in the table below and to increase the funding of each accordingly. All of the FRNs included in this appeal were the subject of the District's February 24, 1999 appeal to the SLD. (See Administrative History/Statement of Facts above). We believe the SLD's failure to list them all in its May 11, 1999 decision was an inadvertent error and should have no bearing on the outcome of this appeal. Changes in discount rates, in any event, should be applied uniformly as a matter of policy to all FRNs issued in the same funding year.

We have completed our review of your FCC Form 471, Services Ordered and Certification Form, and made decisions with respect to your requests for discounts along with other applications received within the same time period. This letter is to advise you of our decisions.

As you may know, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) in June 1998 made two changes to the Universal Service Fund for schools and libraries that have direct bearing on your discount request for 1998. First, the 1998 program year has been extended by six months, for a new ending date of June 30, 1999. Second, the FCC established new funding priorities whereby all eligible applicants will receive discounts for eligible telecommunications services and Internet access. Support for internal connections will be allocated in accordance with need so that schools and libraries will receive discounts in order of the discount percentages for which they qualify beginning with applications qualifying for the highest discount percentages. Discounts for internal connections will continue until all funds are exhausted. These changes are reflected in the information in this letter regarding your discount request.

On the following page(s) is a list, by row of Items 15 and 16 of your FCC Form 471. For each item, there is a Funding Request Number (FRN) and several other

very important pieces of information relating to the disposition of that request. A complete explanation of each item begins below.

If you have any questions about our decisions on your discounts, you may send them in writing to the Schools and Libraries Corporation, Box 125 - Correspondence Unit, 100 South Jefferson Road, Whippany, NJ 07981.

Your next step in the discounting process is to complete and submit the FCC Form 486 enclosed with this letter to notify the SLC that you are currently receiving or have already begun to receive services for which discounts have been approved. This will enable your service providers to invoice SLC for your discounts. Please note that we are notifying each service provider listed on your Form 471 of our decision on your discount request. In addition, you should contact each service provider yourself to make any necessary arrangements regarding start of services, billing of discounts, and any other administrative details relevant to your participation in the Universal Service Fund. For important information about your Form 486, see next page.

FCC Form 471 Applicants who are approved for discount eligibility are reminded that they continue to be subject to audits and other reviews that the SLC may undertake to assure that discounted services are being used in compliance with program rules. If the SLC discovers that discounted services are not being used in compliance with program rules, 471 Applicants will be subject to enforcement activities and other means of recourse by the SLC and other appropriate Federal, state, and local authorities.

#### Explanation of Information Provided in SLC Funding Notification

On the following pages we provide you with a synopsis of the discount eligibility decision for each item you requested. To help understand this synopsis the following definitions are provided:

- \* **Funding Request Number (FRN):** A number assigned by the SLC that will identify a Funding Request. A Funding Request is a single row of item 15 or 16.
- \* **Funding Status:** An item may be "Funded," "Denied," "Partially Funded," or not approved because of "Funds Exhausted." An item that is "Funded" will be approved at the level that SLC determines is appropriate for that item. That will generally be the level requested by the Applicant unless the SLC determines during the application review process that some adjustment is appropriate, for example, a different discount percentage for that item than the FCC Form 471 featured. If an item is "Denied," that denial will be briefly explained in the "Funding Commitment Decision," and amplification of that explanation may be offered in the section, "Funding Commitment Decision Explanation." An item will be "Partially Funded" or "Unfunded," in accordance with FCC program rules, if the total amount of funds in the Universal Service Fund is insufficient to fully fund all approved requests. If the Form 471 was received after all the funds in the Universal Service Fund were allocated and it was processed, the status will indicate "Unfunded - Funds Exhausted."
- \* **SPIN (Service Provider Identification Number):** A unique number assigned to each service provider by the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC).
- \* **Service Provider Name:** The legal name of the service provider.
- \* **Provider Contract Number:** The number of the contract between the eligible party and the service provider. This will be present only if a contract number was provided on Form 471.
- \* **Services Ordered:** The type of service ordered from the service provider, as shown on Form 471.

- \* Earliest Possible Effective Date of Discount: The first possible date of service for which the SLC will reimburse the service provider for discounted services. Note: If the actual service start date provided on a Form 486 is later than this date, the actual service start date set forth in the Form 486 will be the effective date of the discount.
- \* Contract Expiration Date: The date the contract expires. This will be present only if a contract expiration date was provided on Form 471.
- \* Estimated Total Annual Pre-discount Cost: Amount in Column 10 of Item 15/16, Form 471 as determined through the application review process, PLUS an automatic extension of monthly costs for Telecommunications Services and Internet Access through June 30, 1999. Please note that, during the Problem Resolution process at SLC, the amount in Col. 10 of Item 15/16 may have been corrected to conform to the information provided about Service Start Date and Monthly Costs.
- \* Discount Percentage Approved by SLC: This is the discount rate that the SLC has approved for this service.
- \* Funding Commitment Decision: This represents the total amount of funding that the SLC is now reserving to reimburse service providers for the cost of the discount for this service. This figure may be different from the Estimated Total Annual Pre-Discount Cost (Col. 10 of Item 15/16) times the Percentage Discount (Col. 11 of Item 15/16) in your application. It may be higher because of the addition of the monthly cost for Telecommunications Services and Internet Access for the six months from January 1, 1999, through June 30, 1999. It may be lower because of an adjustment determined appropriate by the SLC, such as of the discount percentage, or a denial of discounts and, if so, the accompanying comment will explain this difference. The difference may also reflect a reduction from the request level made necessary by overall funding limitations, in which case the "Funding Status" above will indicate "Partially Funded" or "Unfunded." Whatever amount is listed here, it is important that you and your service provider both recognize that the SLC should be invoiced and the SLC may direct disbursement of discounts on only eligible, approved services actually rendered.
- \* Funding Commitment Decision Explanation: This entry may appear to amplify the comment in the "Funding Commitment Decision," if the discount request for this service is denied for reasons other than "Unfunded" or if the SLC determined that some adjustment to the request level was appropriate.
