HENDERSON DECLARATION

On August 13, 1999, Sonoma Media Corporation filed an Erratum to a "Motion to Withdraw and Dismiss Counterproposal" which it had filed on August 3, 1999. As indicated therein, the original filing was in error in failing to limit the requested withdraw to only a portion of the Sonoma counterproposal i.e. the proposed changes for the community of Cross Plains, Texas, leaving the balance of the Counterproposal intact as submitted.

The Erratum withdrew the original Motion and corrected it to read as a "Motion To Withdraw and Dismiss Part of Counterproposal". As to the Balance of the Sonoma Counterproposal, Sonoma reiterated its continuing interest and commitment to all other changes and representations as included in its original counterproposal. In addition, this same representation of continuing interest and commitment was made on behalf of Rawhide Radio, LLC, the successor to Sonoma as licensee of KVCQ(FM).



The commitments and representations for Sonoma and for Rawhide were supported by the Declaration of Roy E. Henderson, 100% owner of Sonoma, and 51% owner and Chief Operating Officer of Rawhide. A copy of the form of that Declaration was included with the Erratum but as also mentioned there, Henderson was out of the country and the original of his Declaration would have to be sent from Europe. Also as noted therein, the Declaration was reviewed and approved by phone, and the original was then signed and sent by courier. In addition, since the delivery from Germany was delayed, a fax copy of the Declaration was also filed on August 17.

The original of the Declaration arrived from Germany today and is submitted herewith. It is noted that the Declaration is identical to the form of the Declaration as originally filed with the Erratum.

Wherefore, Sonoma Media Corporation respectfully requests that the attached Declaration be associated with the Erratum filed on August 13, 1999, that the proposal for changes in the allocations to Cross Plains, Texas, be deleted and dismissed from the Sonoma Counterproposal, and that the remaining portion of the Sonoma Counterproposal, as now prosecuted by Rawhide Radio, LLC, successor to Sonoma as Licensee of KVCQ(FM), be considered and the remaining requested changes in the Table of Allocations as set forth therein be adopted.

DECLARATION

ROY E. HENDERSON, under penalty of perjury hereby states and declares the following:

That I am the President and sole shareholder of Sonoma Media Corporation, which has been the the sole licensee of Radio Station KVCQ(FM) in Cuero, Texas; and

That Sonoma is the sole proponent of a rulemaking counterproposal filed on December 21, 1998, in MM Docket No. 98-198, styled as Table of Allotments for Cross Plains, Texas, in which it was requested, inter alia, that KVCQ's operating channel of 249C3 in Cuero be moved and upgraded to channel 249C2 in Luling, Texas, and KVCQ's license be modified to that upgraded channel and new community of license.

That on August 3, 1999, I executed a Declaration requesting withdraw and dismissal of the Sonoma Counterproposal in docket 98-198, that that request was in error, and that Sonoma only wishes to request the withdraw and dismissal of a part of that counterproposal, that is the following:


Delete and Withdraw:

and in all other respects intends to continue prosecution of its Counterproposal as submitted, with Rawhide Radio LLC as the new licensee of KVCQ(FM). As majority shareholder and Chief Operating officer of Rawhide, successor to Sonoma as Licensee of KVCQ(FM), Roy E. Henderson reiterates the commitment of Rawhide to all statements made in the Sonoma Counterproposal, except for the specific portion being withdrawn above, including the commitment to reimbursement of all affected channel changes and the commitment to construct and operate the upgraded channel allocation of KVCQ from Cuero to Luling as requested in its Counterproposal if allocated by the Commission.

The above statements of fact are true and correct to the best of my own personal knowledge and belief.


