**PROCEDURE CHANGES – FRONTIER AND GLOBAL CROSSING
APPLICATION SEEKING FCC CONSENT TO TRANSFER CONTROL OF
LICENSES AND AUTHORIZATIONS FROM FRONTIER TO GLOBAL CROSSING
CHANGED TO DOCKETED PROCEEDING**

On May 14, 1999, Public Notice DA 99-921, announced that Frontier Corporation (Frontier) and GlobalCrossing Ltd. (Global Crossing) had filed applications seeking Commission consent to transfer control of licenses and authorizations currently controlled by subsidiaries and affiliates of Frontier to Global Crossing. Public Notice DA 99-921 also established a pleading cycle that closed on June 30, 1999. New filing procedures in this case are established in the following paragraphs.

Interested parties are requested to submit all future filings with the Secretary, FCC at 445 12th Street, SW, TW-A325, Washington, DC 20554. **All pleadings are to reference CC Docket No. 99-264.** Interested parties **that are not filing through the ECFS** should file an original and seven copies of all pleadings. Parties **that are filing** through ECFS should follow the instructions in the following paragraph. An additional copy of all pleadings must be sent to Janice M. Myles, Common Carrier Bureau, FCC, Room 5-C327, 445 12th Street, S.W., Washington, D.C. 20554, and to the Commission's contractor for public services records duplication, International Transcription Services, Inc. (ITS), 1231 20th Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20036. All pleadings in CC Docket No. 99-264 are available for inspection and copying during normal business hours in the FCC's Reference Center, Room CY-A257, 445 12th Street, S.W., Washington, D.C. 20554. Copies also can be obtained from ITS at 1231 20th Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20036, or by calling ITS at (202) 857-3800 or faxing ITS at (202) 857-3805.

Future filings filed through the ECFS can be sent as an electronic file via the Internet to <http://www.fcc.gov/e-file/ecfs.html>. Generally, only one copy of an electronic submission must be filed. If multiple docket or rulemaking numbers appear in the caption of this proceeding, however, filers must transmit one electronic copy of the future filings for each docket or rulemaking number referenced in the caption. In completing the transmittal screen, filers should include their full name, Postal Service mailing address, and the applicable docket or rulemaking number. Parties may also submit an electronic

comment by Internet e-mail. To get filing instructions for e-mail filings, filers should send an e-mail to ecfs@fcc.gov, and should include the following words in the body of the message, "get form <your e-mail address.>" A sample form and directions will be sent in reply.

This proceeding will continue to be governed by "permit but disclose" *ex parte* rules procedures. *See generally* 47 C.F.R. §§ 1.1200-1.1216. Parties making oral *ex parte* presentations are reminded that memoranda summarizing the presentation must contain a summary of the substance of the presentation and not merely a listing of the subjects discussed. More than a one or two sentence description of the views and arguments presented is generally required. *See* 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206(b)(2), as revised. Other rules pertaining to oral and written presentations are set forth in section 1.1206(b) as well. Interested parties are to file with the Secretary, FCC, and serve Janice M. Myles and ITS, with copies of any written *ex parte* presentations or summaries of oral *ex parte* presentations in these proceedings in the manner specified above.
