
On Friday, September 10, 1999, John Nakahata, representing the Coalition for Affordable Local and Long Distance Service ("CALLS") spoke with Ms. Linda Kinney, Legal Adviser to Commissioner Ness, Ms. Sarah Whitesell, Legal Adviser to Commissioner Tristani, Mr. Rich Lerner, Deputy Chief, Competitive Pricing Division, Common Carrier Bureau. In each of these conversations, Mr. Nakahata urged that the FCC seek public comment on the CALLS proposal soon, and that comment cycles should be determined in a manner that would permit FCC action with respect to the proposal in time for January 2000 implementation.
