O R D E R

Issued: September 3, 1999 ; Released: September 7, 1999

The Presiding Judge is persuaded by the Status Report On Discovery filed by Adams Communications Corporation ("Adams") on August 23, 1999, that an extension of the discovery cut-off date beyond the current date of September 24, 1999, is justified. Order FCC 99M-42, released July 15, 1999. Since that date was set, there has been an expansion of the renewal period which justifies more time to prepare. Memorandum Opinion and Order, FCC 99M-47, released August 9, 1999.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that without interfering with presently scheduled discovery, the discovery cut-off date of September 24, 1999, IS CANCELLED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that counsel for the parties shall confer on a revised discovery, procedural and hearing schedule.



<sup>1</sup> Reading Broadcasting, Inc. ("Reading") also filed its Status Report On Discovery on August 23, 1999. Reading has not requested a change of the discovery cut-off date or of the procedural and hearing dates. Reading objects to the scope of Adams' contemplated discovery. But there has been no motion for a protective order filed. The Mass Media Bureau has filed no pleading with respect to the parties' discovery.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties SHALL SUBMIT jointly (or individually) a revised discovery, procedural and hearing schedule by **September 8, 1999**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a Prehearing Conference IS SET for **September 10, 1999**, at **9:30 a.m.**<sup>2</sup>
