This is to advise the Commission that representatives of MRFAC, Inc. including Marvin W. McKinley, President and other MRFAC members, met with Kathleen Ham and Ramona Melson on September 15 regarding private radio issues.

The MRFAC representatives stressed their opposition to auctions for the 450-470 MHz band; the desirability of user fees which would reward spectrum efficiency and penalize inefficiency; the importance of securing a new allocation for private radio; and the need for rescission of the shared frequency coordination rule as requested in MRFAC's pending Petition for Partial Reconsideration in the Re-farming proceeding.
