On Thursday, September 23, 1999, C. Michael Armstrong, James Cicconi, and I, of AT&T, and Michael Hammer of Willkie Farr & Gallagher, met with Rick Chessen, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Tristani. We discussed the need to conform the cable horizontal ownership and attribution rules to the programming concerns underlying the cable horizontal ownership statute. We also discussed the impact of the cable horizontal ownership and attribution rules upon the proposed merger of AT&T and MediaOne.
