Dear Ms. Salas:

Please be advised that, on Tuesday, September 28th, Paul K. Mancini, General Attorney and Assistant General Counsel of SBC, Martin E. Grambow, Vice President and General Counsel of SBC Telecommunications, Inc., and Priscilla Hill-Ardoin, Senior Vice President – FCC made an oral ex parte presentation to Sarah Whitesell, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Gloria Tristani in connection with the above-referenced matter. The purpose of this presentation was to discuss a quarterly reporting requirement on SBC/Ameritech's progress in rolling out xDSL services.

SBC/Ameritech agreed to include a new reporting condition to the xDSL rollout condition. Specifically, SBC/Ameritech agreed to add a subparagraph "d" to paragraph 22 of the proposed conditions, to read as follows:

"d. SBC/Ameritech shall file a quarterly report with the Commission describing the status of its xDSL rollout. This report shall include xDSL deployment information by SBC/Ameritech state, including the number and name/location of urban and rural wire centers and low-income wire centers where SBC/Ameritech has deployed xDSL. The first report shall be submitted 180 days after the Merger Closing Date and on a quarterly basis thereafter."
